SAFETY POLICIES

Please remember that there is NO RUNNING in the theatre.

For everyone's safety, dancing, acrobatics, stretching and warmups are prohibited in the Main Lobby and hallways.

The Mezzanine Lobby and the center of the Renaissance Room may be used for that purpose. Please be mindful of other dancers who also need to warm up.

FIRE DOORS, aisles and exits must not be blocked. Your personal items will be moved if they are blocking an exit.

- For your convenience, if dressing rooms are not assigned, there are large dressing rooms located backstage left and right, two on each side of the stage – level 2 and level 3. We encourage you to make full use of them. The Renaissance Room is located Front of House at the 2nd level and can be used as an overflow dressing room if it is available. **We discourage “dressing room” luggage and pop-up tents**

NO HELIUM BALLOONS IN THE BUILDING

Anyone under 14 MUST be accompanied by a parent, teacher or responsible adult, especially while using the elevator.

If sitting on the lobby floor, please be mindful of other guests and do not block doors to offices, exit doors or general lobby areas. We are required to keep Exit Doors and Exit Routes clear at all times.

Please do not adhere (no tape, putty, command strips) anything to a painted surface.

Climbing on or hanging from railings and window sills is strictly prohibited at all times.

Unattended curling irons and other electrical devices must be turned off.

Please help us keep The Carolina Theatre clean. There are trash receptacles throughout the venue. If those are full, please contact a staff member.
