PLEASE TAKE NOTE: NO Food or Drink (Only bottled water) is allowed backstage or in the dressing areas. Please be respectful if the Venue does not allow food and drink in the facility.

Each routine will receive an Adjudicated Award. In each Level and Age Division, Top Score Awards will be presented. The number of Top Score Awards will be based on the number of entries in a given level and age division. **National Judges' Bravo & Specialty Awards** will be given at each session. **High Voltage Awards** are Instant Awards given during group sessions for routines that stand out for Powerful Performances!

ADJUDICATED AWARDS: Gold, High Gold, Elite Gold, Platinum, Power Platinum, Power Diamond

COMPETITIVE LEVELS: Recreational, Intermediate, Advanced (Tiny Age 6 & under does have levels)

AGE DIVISIONS: Tiny (6 & Under), Mini (7-8), Petite (9-10), Junior (11-12), Teen (13-14), Senior (15-19), and Elite Adult (20+) **Senior Solos are divided into (15-16) & (17-19) when entries merit a split**

At DANCE MACHINE, we take care of Photos and Videos for you, and we do it for FREE!

You can claim your FREE Photo and Video on the Dakiki App. The QR Code can be found as a PDF on our Website on each Regional & National City Page, and there will be Signs Around the Venue. QR Codes are for iPhones and Androids. The Dakiki App is also where you will find a printable program, meet the judges, and follow along with the competition on the app to see what routine is on stage and up next.

Please Do Not Monopolize the Dressing Rooms; they are used for changing, and we can all work together to keep them clean and have space for everyone. Please do not change costumes in the Restrooms or those not designated as Changing Areas. The Dressing Rooms are not for Practicing or Eating. Keeping the dressing rooms clean promotes healthy habits and prevents costumes from being damaged or lost. Having your name on all of your items is always a good idea. Then, if they are lost, it is much more efficient to locate the owner of the lost item.

Remember your Manners when at a Dance Competition. We kindly ask that you stay seated while dancers perform a routine on stage. When the routine is over and the performers exit the stage, you may get up between routines.

Let's all be mindful of Noise in the Audience. When it gets loud, it can be picked up in the Judges' Critiques, making it difficult for them to hear and focus on the routine on the stage. Everyone deserves the same performance opportunity, so let's keep our voices and noise down in the audience!

How does the Clash of the Champions work? The Clash of the Champions is a Group Dance-Off to determine the 2025 Dance Machine ANDC Super Grand National Champion. There will be a Clash of the Champions for 8 & Under (Tiny & Mini Groups), Petite Groups (9-10), Junior Groups (11-12), Teen Groups (13-14), and Senior Groups (15-19). At the end of the Group Awards for each Session, the Top 6 or 8 Groups will be announced (each studio can only have 1 group in each Clash of the Champions). Hence, each studio represented will be the highest scoring routine from that studio re-competing for a chance at the Super Grand National Champion. Groups will be announced in random order. They will be released, and then each group will have 10 minutes to change into their costume for the dance that is in the Clash and return backstage ready to perform. They will pick one representative to pull a number, determining the order in which they perform in the Clash of the Champions. All groups in the Clash of the Champions have a clean slate... no previous scores come with the routine, and one judge sits out, and we bring in a Wild Card Judge who has not seen any of the groups in the session to judge each Clash. Then, the scores are tabulated to determine the Super Grand National Champion. It's exciting, thrilling, and Powerfully Awesome!

All the same dancers who performed in the group session must perform in the Clash of the Champions, or the group may not participate in the Clash. If the entire group is not backstage in the 10 minutes allotted in costume, ready to perform, they will not be included in the Clash. This is not to be mean; however, to be fair!

After the performance, the dancers in each group will stay backstage and line up ready to return to the stage for the Awards. This is a very quick process. Please do not come get your dancers. If they leave at any point during the Clash, the group will forfeit any placement or awards from the Clash of the Champions.

The Clash of the Productions is a session without a Dance-Off. The Production Performance will be the Clash Performance, and the Super Grand National Production Champion will be awarded in the Production Clash Session.

**In the event of an extenuating circumstance the decision of Dance Machine ANDC Directors/National Crew will be final and accepted.

This is an exciting part of the National Championships, just making it into the Clash of the Champions is a huge accomplishment. Be proud, be excited, give it your all, and no matter the outcome know that you came to Dance Machine ANDC and were Powerfully Awesome!!!
